

**Meeting Minutes of the 2024 2nd Meeting of Open Data Advisory Group,  
Ministry of Finance**

**I. Time: 2023/12/24, 2:30 P.M.**

**II. Location: Fiscal Information Agency (hereinafter referred to as “FIA”) 102 Conference Room**

**III. Reporting Matters:**

**1.Digital Development Ministry's (hereinafter referred to as “MODA”) "Government Open Data Incentive Program" for 2024 and required follow-up actions by the Ministry of Finance(hereinafter referred to as “MOF”).**

Resolution:

1. The case is retained for future reference. Each department and institution of the MOF shall follow the planning of the FIA to conduct the open dataset quality inspection actively according to the yearly regulations announced by the MODA, in order to maintain the MOF open dataset quality as well as increase the effectiveness of the MOF open data usage.
2. Upon the MODA’s announcement of the "Open Data Quality Label and Application Incentive Measures" for 2025, the FIA shall develop an implementation timeline and notify all relevant units accordingly.

**2. MODA’s continuous promotion of "High-Value Application Data."**

Resolution:

The case is retained for future reference. The Customs Administration is requested to periodically review, evaluate, and update the two datasets included in the "Sustainable Agriculture" high-value theme. Other units of the MOF should cooperate with MODA in selecting relevant high-value data topics and submit financial datasets according to the prescribed reporting procedures.

**3.MODA’s request for agencies under the Executive Yuan to enhance the quality of open government data.**

Resolution:

1. Approved for future reference, Agencies should accurately complete metadata descriptions for datasets as MODA’s regulations.
2. MODA plans to incorporate AI-usable data into the open government data . Agencies should continue improving data quality and adhere to future policies and timelines announced by MODA.

3. Once MODA announces the " Awarding Program of Quality Certification and Deepen Application of Government Open Data" for the following year, the FIA should plan the implementation timeline and notify all relevant units accordingly.
