

**Meeting Minutes of the 2021 1st Meeting of Open Data Advisory Group,
Ministry of Finance**

I. Meeting Description: Due to concern over the COVID 19 pandemic, the meeting was held in the form of documentary review which was decided by the chairman.

II. Meeting Procedure: The meeting materials were sent to the Open Data Advisory Group members on 10th August, 2021, and the review opinions were collected by the Fiscal Information Agency.

III. Reporting Matters:

1. The content of the 2021 “Government Open Data Rewarding Event” held by the National Development Council (hereinafter referred to as “NDC”) is provided for public record and review.

Resolution: The case is reviewed by all members with no comments, and is retained for future reference.

2. The current status of each department and institution of the Ministry of Finance (hereinafter referred to as “MOF”) conducting the 2021 “Government Open Data Rewarding Event” is provided for public record and review.

Resolution:

- (1) The case is reviewed by all members with no comments, and is retained for future reference.
- (2) Each department and institution of the MOF shall give priority to meet public needs when conducting the open data. When updating and revising the datasets, each department and institution of the MOF shall pass the gold label certification inspection in order to maintain the open data quality of the MOF and increase the efficiency for public use.
- (3) As the NDC has listed the OpenAPI and platinum label certification as bonus categories, each department and institution of the MOF shall continue to increase the quantity of OpenAPI and platinum label certification, in order to improve the open data quality of the MOF.
