

Format of Manuscript Submitted for Public Finance Review

- I. Chinese font of the manuscript should be PmingLiU. and English should be Times New Roman in 14pt font size, with 25pt line spacing, and furthermore, a summary of about 200 words should be added.
- II. The order of the paragraph structure is as follows:
One, I, (I), 1., (1), A., (a)
- III. The title of the table should be placed above the table, while the title of the figure should be below. Moreover, both the source and footnotes should be placed below the table/figure.
- IV. Reference format
 - (I) Chinese reference (arranged in stroke order by surname)
 1. Book
Author (AD year), *title* (version), place of publication: publisher.
 2. Periodicals
Author (AD year), “article title” , *book or journal title (in italics)*, issue, page number.
Example: Wang Xiaoming (2005), “Study on ○○ in Small Open Economies” , *○○ Policy*, 41, 19-22.
 3. Thesis
Author (AD year), “thesis title” , *the thesis of the school department (in italics)*.
Example: He Xiaohua (2014) , “○○○” , *master's (or doctoral) thesis of ○○ Institute of ○○ University* .
 4. Seminar paper
Author (AD year), “paper title” , seminar name, organizer.
Example: Wang Daming (March 2015), “○○○” ,○○○ seminar on ○○○, organized by the Department of ○○ , National ○○ University .
 5. Websites and other online material

Author (AD year), article title, affiliated institutions, [http://](http://.....)
(II) English reference (arranged in alphabetical order by first letter of surname)

1. Book

Author (AD year), *Book Title (in italics)*, Publisher: Publisher
(first letter capitalized)

Example: Savas, E. S. (2000), *Privatization and Public-Private Partnerships*, New York: Chatham House.

2. Periodicals

Author (AD year), Article title, *Book title or magazine title (italics)*, Issue, page number.

Example: Mundell, Robert (1961), A theory of optimal currency areas, *American Economic Review*, 51(4), 657-665.
